The meeting was called to order at 10:00 AM by Chairman Adamson. The Open Meetings Act Notice was announced. The minutes of the last regular meeting were read. Commissioner Adamson moved to approve the minutes as read. Commissioner Van Winkle seconded the motion. Roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Storer-aye. Commissioner Van Winkle-aye. Commissioner Adamsonaye. The motion carried.

The minutes from the August 29, 2016 special meeting were read. Commissioner Van Winkle moved to approve minutes as read. Commissioner Adamson seconded the motion. Roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Storer-aye. Commissioner Adamson-aye. Commissioner Van Winkle-aye. The motion carried.

The minutes from the August 30, 2016 Board of Corrections meeting were read. Commissioner Storer moved to approve minutes as read. Commissioner Adamson seconded the motion. Roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Van Winkle-aye. Commissioner Adamson-aye. Commissioner Storer-aye. The motion carried.

The Board reviewed the fiscal year-end inventory reports for the various county departments. It was the consensus of the Board to accept the inventories as submitted.

The Board reviewed some surplus road equipment. Commissioner Adamson moved to declare a 2000 GMC dump truck, a 1992 Ford dump truck, and a 1994 Ford tractor as surplus property to the county and authorize their disposition by sale or trade. Commissioner Van Winkle seconded the motion. Roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Storer-aye. Commissioner Van Winkle-aye. Commissioner Adamson-aye. The motion carried.

Commissioner Adamson moved to set October 11, 2016 at 2:00 PM for a public hearing to consider an application for a conditional use permit for Sharp's campground. Commissioner Storer seconded the motion. Roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Van Winkleave. Commissioner Storer-aye. Commissioner Adamson-aye. The motion carried.

It was the consensus of the board to allow Chairman Adamson to sign an engagement agreement with the State Auditor's Office to perform Cherry County's annual audit for fiscal year 2015-2016.

The Board reviewed the fee report from the Clerk of the District Court for the month of August.

At 2:00 PM, as advertised, Chairman Adamson opened the public hearing to consider the proposed budget for Cherry County for fiscal year 2016-2017. John Ravenscroft and Carolyn Semin attended the hearing. No testimony was received in opposition to the proposed budget. At 2:50 PM, Chairman Adamson closed the hearing.

Chairman Adamson moved to increase the County's prior year restricted funds authority by the statutorily allowed 2.5%. Commissioner Van Winkle seconded the motion. Roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Storer-aye. Commissioner Van Winkle-aye. Commissioner Adamson-aye. The motion carried.

Chairman Adamson moved to approve an additional 1.0% increase to the prior year restricted funds authority. Commissioner Van Winkle seconded the motion. Roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Storer-aye. Commissioner Van Winkle-aye. Commissioner Adamson-aye. The motion carried.

At 3:00 PM, as advertised, Chairman Adamson opened the special hearing to consider setting the final tax request for 2016-2017. No testimony was received in opposition to the proposed levy. After further discussion, Chairman Adamson closed the hearing at 3:20 PM.

Chairman Adamson moved to adopt the 2016-2017 budget for Cherry County setting the final tax request at \$4,174,591.00 and setting the final property tax levy at .215704, compared to the prior year levy of .323139. Commissioner Van Winkle seconded the motion. Roll call vote was taken. Commissioner Storer-aye. Commissioner Van Winkle-aye. Commissioner Adamson-aye. The motion carried.

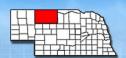
